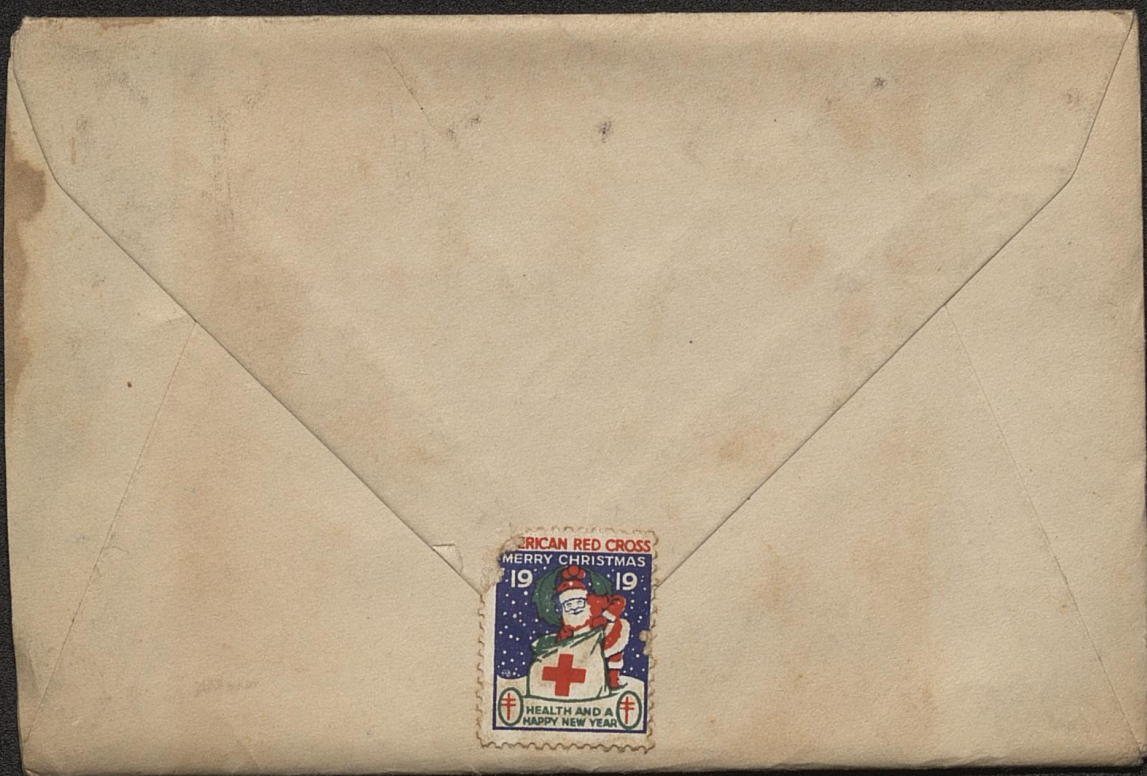


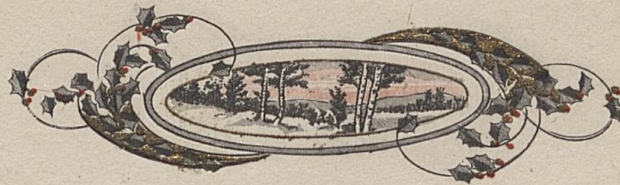

I certainly feel glad. I gave out
my first report cards last nite.
Wonda is teaching too, but her
school just started last Tuesday.
I never thought we'd ever
teach school, but here we are.

How is the weather there? We
had a snow here last Monday,
and Tuesday, but its about all
gone now. I'm teaching at
Fairburn, a little berg about
25 miles from Custer. I've been
home twice since school started,
the 14th of Sept. Wonda's school

is west of Custer & mine is east. He's
is at Pringle, that is about 12 mi. from
Custer, so you see she isn't quite so
far from home. It surely seems
funny and lonesome too to be separated.
