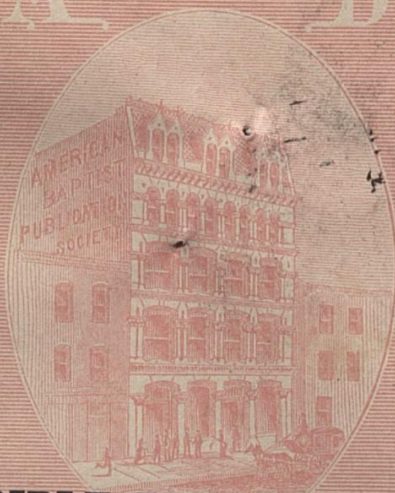

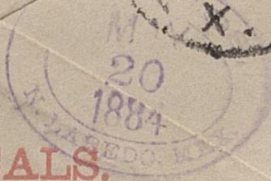

Dear Bro. Dr. Law of Bryan. Texas, has sent me a letter from Rev. D. A. Wilson, Guadalajara, to him, asking for Spanish scriptures and requesting that a fund be raised in Texas for him and for his field. I write to inquire if you can supply him from the scriptures sent to you. If not please give me information and state your opinion of the request and then, without any doubt, our Board will make an additional appropriation if needed. In all such cases if you desire supplies for the missionaries on your field and in connection with your work and will disburse them to these missionaries according to your judgment and as needed, you can always secure a supply by dropping me a letter stating numbers, manner of shipment, &c., &c. In every case where our missionaries at any time have made application the Board has cordially made appropriations of scriptures on the usual conditions.

You need not let this inquiry of mine be known but I state the fact.

Besides this the Board recently sent \$1000 to the Foreign Mission Board at Richmond as a donation for Bible work on the fields occupied by that Board, but Mexico has usually been supplied with scriptures shipped from here, so also Cuba. You know my warm sympathy for your work and for you personally and our willingness to do anything we can to help you along in the cause. An early reply will oblige.

On my personal order Mr. Caleb T. Rowe, American Bible Society, shipped by Southern Pacific Co., April 6, '87, one box, 200 Spanish Reference Bibles, 16mo., net weight 259 lbs., addressed to you, Saltillo, Mexico, Care Belden Bros., Laredo, Texas, via Corpus Christi, Morgan Line, for which I have bill of lading. I have this day sent him my check for the full amount of this bill, a donation of these scriptures to you.

A few days ago I wrote to you stating that I had sent Mr. Rowe this order proposing to pay him personally 50 per cent discount. Mr. Rowe did not reply but I received a very angry and unprovoked letter from Dr. Gilman, one of the Secretaries, in which he makes his flings as Baptists as usual, and declines to fill the order. I advise you hereafter to make no applications whatever to him. That Society has treated us, denominationally, iniquitously and there is no necessity for braving their taunting insults when we have an organization of our own, to which our people should rally and would rally if they knew the facts. Our separate Bible work has been forced upon the denomination and without loss of our self respect we cannot go to them. They

Yours of 11th received. I do not believe that any harm is done even if Dr. Gilman is angry. They have never had any heart feelings of kindness and sympathy with Baptists and among the Presbyterians especially there is not one glimmer of good feeling about your inroads. We see it in print and hear it in preaching in this region and if I did not know you I might think you are dreadful wicked and mean, regular filibusters, invading "ecclesiastical preserves." I, however, strongly suspect there is a good deal of truth in it.

I have not the slightest objection to having you get all you can out of the American Bible Society. We are entirely willing to do whatever we are able and have shown this, but they get all the money they can from Baptists and Baptist churches and give little or nothing back. I ordered the books to be shipped precisely according to the instructions given me in your letter and they went care of Belden Bros

We are not, at this time, able to appoint another additional colporteur anywhere. Our books are not yet balanced but we are trembling lest there should be debt.

I am sorry that you cannot attend the S.B.C. but will not give up the hope of meeting you until I find you have failed to come.
